By 1802, the French government was taken over by a popular general who became the most powerful leader in Europe, Napoleon Bonaparte. How did Napoleon gain popularity in France?

The Directory lost control of the political situation and the people in France. The only control that they had was over the army. Abbie Sieyes (Speaker from the National Assembly) urged Napoleon to stage a "Coup d'état" (overthrow of state).

The French were desperate for strong leadership. The people looked to Napoleon to provide a strong central government and to achieve the goals of the Revolution such as equality in law, due process, natural rights, the power of citizens over monarch, freedom of religion, freedom of speech, and separation of powers.
